

## AMERICAN FORK JR. HIGH INTERNET USE POLICY

The use of the Internet can significantly increase student access to educational data from around the world. The nature of the Internet does not allow control or assure that the information accessed is accurate, complete or current. It may be questionable; of a controversial in nature; offensive; or illegal. However, we have found the Internet to be a valuable educational tool. Filtering provided through the Utah Education Network helps deny some access. However, no filter can be totally effective. However, it does block some known objectionable sites. Ultimately the user is responsible for what is accessed on the Internet. Users should be good information consumers and question the validity of the information. Should the user inadvertently access inappropriate or objectionable information, they must immediately notify the instructor.

Unacceptable use of the Internet includes, but is not limited to, the following:

1. violation of computer security
2. unauthorized use of computer accounts or access codes
3. use of the computer that impedes activities of others or disruption of the network
4. violation of software license agreements
5. violation of network usage policies and regulations
6. violation of user policy
7. destruction or damage to equipment, software, or data belonging to the school
8. unauthorized use or destruction of data belonging to others
9. harassing, libeling, or slandering others
10. displaying or disseminating sexually suggestive (obscene/pornographic) material on or through the computer
11. using the Internet without displaying your Internet Authorization card
12. allowing others to use your card or watch while you use the Internet
13. accessing chat rooms, news groups, games
- 14. sending or receiving e-mail**
15. any use for commercial purposes or financial gain, any use for product advertisement, political activities or political lobbying
16. spreading of computer viruses
17. vulgar language
18. sending personal information such as home address and/or telephone number

Unacceptable use of the Internet will result in the loss of all Internet access privileges any where in the school and potentially a loss of other computer privileges. Illegal use of the computer or Internet will be turned over to the proper authorities for prosecution.

In order to use the Internet the student must:

1. have the Internet Access application signed by the sponsoring teacher, student, and parent and on file
2. log-in with the instructor
3. display the Internet Access Card as specified by the instructor
4. follow all School, District, and UEN Internet/computer policies
